IF YOU ARE NOT REGISTERED AND DO NOT MEET ONE OF THE ABOVE EXEMPTIONS:

If you are between the ages of 18 and 25, you are required to register with the Selective Service.

if you are age 26 or older and are a veteran of military service other than the reserve forces, Delayed Entry Pool or the National Guard, simply attach a copy of your DD-214 "Certificate of Release or Discharge from Active Duty" to this form and submit to the Financial Aid Office.

if you are age 26 or older and you are not a veteran, follow these instructions:

1. Call the Selective Service at (847)688-6888 and tell them you need a "Status Information Letter". They will send you a form to complete. Return the completed form to the Selective Service.
2. The Selective Service will then send you a Status Information Letter. If the Status Information Letter verifies that you are not required to be registered, simply attach a copy to this form and submit to the Financial Aid Office. If the Status Information Letter does not verify that you are not required to be registered, attach a copy of the letter to this form and also attach a letter explaining why you failed to register.
