MATH 093	<p>Units: 4</p> <p>Lecture: 4 hours per week.</p> <p>Catalog Description: A review of high school geometry, including mathematical logic, geometric constructions, congruences, similarities, and other properties of basic closed plane figures.</p> <p>Schedule Description: A review of high school geometry, including mathematical logic, geometric constructions, congruences, similarities, and other properties of basic closed plane figures.</p>	FA08	<p>The content of the course in the current outline exceeds what can be covered in a three unit course if it is to be covered in the depth that is expected in a college-level course. Comparable geometry courses at other colleges are four unit courses. Beginning Algebra and Intermediate Algebra at San Bernardino Valley College are both four unit courses. These courses cover about twenty-five sections in each textbook, while the geometry course covers thirty-three sections of its textbook.</p>
