**PROGRAM NAME CHANGE**

The Family and Consumer Science offerings formerly included a broader range of courses. Currently the courses are limited to courses related to foods and nutrition. After researching program titles in other institutions the faculty chair and articulation officer recommended a title change to be more recognizable for students and transfer institutions.

The Family and Consumer Science program received Curriculum Committee approval to be re-named Foods and Nutrition to more accurately reflect the focus of the program. Upon approval of the program name change by the Board of Trustees, the department will begin the curriculum process of updating courses and certificates to change the identification from Family and Consumer Science to Foods and Nutrition.
