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DISCUSSION TOPICS

CURRICULUM HANDBOOK – Achala invited the committee to send her suggestions for updates to the handbook. By the end of the semester, Achala will give a marked up copy to Nicole so that the handbook can be updated over the summer break.

ACTIVE COURSES — Currently there are many courses in the Curricunet with duplicate "active" versions. These versions are approved by the board on different dates are very confusing as it is hard to determine which version is the latest and the current version of the Course Outline of Record. There should be only one "Active" version of courses. The duplicate versions were created when only "DE" proposal was proposed by the originator and approved by the committee. The committee recommended that the Office of Instruction combine the two "Active" versions of courses into one so that there is only one latest version of the "Active "course. The committee also recommended that the instruction office to get Curricunet updated to delete the DE only options so that this problem does not occur in the future.

PENDING COURSES - Many course updates and new proposals have been started in the Curricunet, but not completed, sometimes for as long as 5 years. Some of the originators of these courses have retired or moved on to new jobs. These incomplete courses clutter up the Curricunet. When new software updates are implemented, the courses created under very old versions of Curricunet create unexpected glitches in the approval cycle. The committee recommended that if the originator does not shepherd the course through the entire approval cycle in two years then the course should be deleted. Larry Buckley suggested that a form letter be created to allow Instruction Office staff to delete the courses. Kay Ragan recommended that the Deans need to discuss the process to be followed to delete these incomplete proposals at the upcoming IO cabinet meeting.
