Instructor student contact will take place weekly using the following: Threaded discussion forums, weekly announcements, instructor prepared material, timely feedback on exams, projects, and assignments, posting videos, synchronous and asynchronous office hours, and communication to the students. Also, in face to face portion of the course which is the lab portion. The lecture portion of this course will be fully online.

Student to student contact will take place on a weekly basis in threaded discussion discussions, Peer to peer feedback, synchronous online meetings and in the face to face labs.

- 8. Describe what students in this online version of the course will do in a typical week on this class. Include the process starting after initial log in.**

The students would login to Canvas open the weekly module, watch videos, read instructor generated material, and complete assignments during the week. The student will also attend this face to face lab with the instructor on campus each week for the duration of the course. The reason this is a hybrid course is due to classroom space. It is easier to have the lecture online and the labs face to face.

This is a hybrid course with face to face with scheduled lab meetings four times a week. The lecture portion of this course will be online. During this course, the instructor will be working closely with students in the online portion and the face to face lab portion of class. The online lecture portion of this course will have zoom lectures once weekly and the instructor will give timely feedback on all submitted assignments. The instructor will have scheduled office hours via zoom twice weekly.

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Student to student interaction will take place in the face to face lab and weekly in the online portion of the course in the threaded discussions and peer to peer feedback.

11. Provide a specific example of how regular and effective instructor-student interaction may occur in this online course.

Instructor to student interaction will take place weekly in the face to face labs and on the zoom lecture meeting that will take place once a week. In addition, interaction students will interact with the instructor within speed grader and chat in canvas. The instructor will give the student feedback within a 24 -hour period. The instructor will be available to the student in the face to face labs and in synchronous office hours which will be set up to be by appointment only.

12. Does this course include lab hours? No Yes – If yes, how are you going to accommodate the typical face to face activities in an online environment?

The lab will be held face to face. If the campus closes and the lab is moved online then the instructor will record him or herself doing a demo of the weekly lessons and posting for the students to use as an example of what they need to do for the lab portion of the course for the week. Students would then join a synchronous meeting to discuss and show other students their project and how it turned out. Students can talk to each other about the issues they had creating the project. The online lecture portion of the course would remain the same.
