## Geology 200 (4 units) Rocks and Rock Minerals

(3 hours of Lecture per Week and 3 hours of laboratory per week)

## Lecture (3 units)

- 1. Students will correctly identify common rock-forming mineral characteristics on a quiz or exam.
- 2. Students will correctly identify common rock characteristics on a quiz or exam.
- 3. Students will correctly label major components on an Earth-interior model on a quiz or exam.

## Laboratory (1 unit)

- 1. Students will correctly identify the standard minerals within the Mohs scale of mineral hardness.
- 2. Students will correctly identify common rock-forming mineral hand samples using basic diagnostic tests, including color, luster, streak, cleavage, acid effervescence, and density.
- 3. Students will correctly identify common rock hand samples using classroom, laboratory, and field knowledge.
