Language and Culture

SLO #1: Students will demonstrate their understanding of the conceptual framework that guides the anthropological study of linguistics evaluated by a written or objective assessment.

SLO #2: Students will demonstrate their understanding of sociolinguistics and the relationship between language and cultural identity evaluated by a written assessment.

Course Description

This course is an anthropological analysis of the study of language. An examination of topics includes anthropological theories on language, biology, and sociocultural practices that direct the development of language. An emphasis will be placed on the relationship between culture and language, variation and power including verbal and non-verbal communication.
