Higher grade point averages and retention/persistence rates have been seen in each of the Valley-Bound Commitment cohort classes since 2008.

In November 2010, the California Community College State Chancellor's Office named the Valley-Bound Commitment as the top student success program in all of California. It is my belief that this prestigious award would not have been possible without the day-in/day-out commitment on the individual student level by Carmen Rodriguez and the Valley-Bound Commitment team.
