Provide a rationale for your request (Give a detailed explanation of why this budget increase is needed.) This budget increase is needed so that the Transfer and Career Center can purchase more medals and frames for transferring students at the Transfer Ceremony, purchase t-shirts for SBVC "Transfer Advocates", and provide giveaways at New Student Welcome Day, Senior Day, and the Black Excellence Educational Summit; all of which promote a transfer culture. Providing giveaways such as t-shirts that encourage students to transfer help promote a transfer culture on campus. It sends the message that as an institution we value academics and transfer. Further, it reminds students that we offer Transfer and Career services on campus. They are also helpful recruitment tools at events such as Senior Day and the Black Excellence Educational Summit, where students are still deciding where they will go to college. Seeing that we promote transfer and offer transfer services, helps high school seniors decide to come to Valley and be secure in knowing that we will help them transfer out and help them reach their end goal. Additionally, it helps high school counselors be confident that their students will receive the services they need at Valley. This also helps us break the stigma and stereotypes around community colleges.

Our latest Efficacy Report lists an Action Plan (p.4), as "continually work with faculty and other student services to identify potential transfer students through various outreach strategies and databases to promote transfer reading and culture." The ability to recognize Transfer Advocates with a t-shirt, and provide promotional items helps us address

this action plan. Not only do promos and giveaways incentivize events, and promote transfer culture, but they are also a recruitment tool for incoming students.

The new Student Centered Funding Formula focuses on how well students are achieving their stated goals. There are 3 calculations in the new formula, one of which is the student success allocation that includes the number of students transferring to four-year colleges and universities. Future state funds are tied to the transfer success of our students. In order for the Transfer Center to achieve its goals of creating a transfer culture and cultivating transfer awareness, it is necessary to be an adequately funded department.
