At this time San Bernardino Valley College does not meet Title IX regulations in regards to providing "same opportunity". Currently our softball team practices and competes at Cesar Chavez park in the city of Colton. Because our softball program is off campus we cannot provide the same support as we do for other programs on campus. We do not provide proper field maintenance. We do not provide access to an athletic trainer or training room facilities. We do not provide locker rooms or proper storage for equipment. All just stated are the basic support we provide to all the other programs on campus. The softball field at Chavez park is not a safe, clean environment. The field is in need of repair. The dugouts are used a urinals.

There is drug use and gang activity in the park. The softball field/program needs to come back to our campus ASAP to ensure our students have a safe, clean environment with proper support from the campus.
