ORDINANCE TWELVE: Requirement that All SBVC-Based Club Members Have ASB Card with Current Sticker

BACKGROUND: The Associated Student Body, which includes the Inter-Club Council, has been negligent in the past in raising funds. One of the major ways to raise operational funds has been through sales of ASB stickers. Last year, sales were way below expectations. Presently, one of the requirements for holding a student government office is an ASB card with a current sticker. It would stand to reason that since ICC funding does come from the ASB, all campus-based club members ought to be ASB cardholders with current stickers.

PROPOSAL: We propose that the following ORDINANCE be implemented in order to support the various student-based entities here on campus.

ORDINANCE TWELVE

ALL MEMBERS OF SAN BERNARDINO VALLEY COLLEGE-BASED CLUBS
SHALL BE REQUIRED TO HAVE CURRENT
ASSOCIATED STUDENT BODY CARDS AND STICKERS:

All members of campus-based clubs at San Bernardino Valley College shall be required to obtain current A.S.B. cards and/or stickers each semester. Cards and/or stickers must be obtained within thirty (30) days from the beginning of each semester. Each club – within a week after the thirty (30) days are up – shall submit a written list of its club members, indicating whether their members have complied with this ordinance to the Inter-Club Council Commissioner or his or her designated appointee. Sanctions and/or penalties for clubs failing to comply will be at the sole discretion and full agreement of each of the executive board.

This ORDINANCE for the 2005-2006 Legislative Year, if approved, shall be become effective at the commencement of the fall 2005 semester – that day being Monday, August 15, 2005 – in time for the first scheduled fall meeting held the following week at 2:00 PM on Tuesday, August 23, 2005.
