SBVC – Region IX Involvement

SBVC has stepped up to the plate. On September 19, 2008, Region IX colleges met at Riverside Community College Norco Campus. During this meeting elections for Region IX officers were held. I'm happy to report that 3 of the 8 executive positions were filled by SBVC students. Congratulations to your SBVC elects: Robert Alexander, Vice-President Region IX, Eric Gonzalez, Technical Commutations Officer Region IX and Javier Alcaraz Region IX Senator. We will be sending 3 student representatives to the Statewide Student Senate Fall General Assembly, October 24-26, 2008 in San Jose, CA.

ASG Strategic Planning

The ASG has completed their strategic planning process during which the organization developed goals and objectives for the 2008-2009 academic year. We are currently in the process of identifying benchmarks for success and methods of evaluation for each goal/objective. Furthermore, each member has completed individual goals and objectives for the year (please see attached).

Recruitment and Appointment of ASG Officers and Committee Members

For the first time in many years, ASG has filled 100% of our positions in the Legislative and Judicial branches respectively. As a result of our recruitment efforts, we also have approximately 60 more students who are interested in serving on an ASG or Shared Governance Committee.
