Dues are forwarded to the State Honor Society to keep AGS Delta Chapter active and in good standing (required for member scholarship eligibility).

Current dues are \$10 for <u>initial or temporary</u> **active** membership, \$15 for <u>initial or temporary</u> **inactive** membership and \$5 for all **continuing** members (either active or inactive). Fees are waived for **permanent** members (60 units, 3.5 GPA or two semesters 3.25 GPA). See the descriptions on the next page to decide which applies to you.

INITIAL MEMBERSHIP is open to students who have completed the equivalent of 12 transferable semester units (excluding credit/no credit courses) with a <u>cumulative</u> GPA of 3.0 or higher.

TEMPORARY MEMBERSHIP is open to students who are life members of the California Scholarship Federation (CSF) or who have a high school GPA of 3.5 or higher and who are in their first semester of college.

CONTINUING MEMBERSHIP is open to initial or temporary members who continue to maintain a <u>cumulative</u> **GPA of 3.0 or higher at SBVC.** Members are responsible to renew their own membership every semester by submitting a completed application, their most recent transcript, and a \$5.00 CBO receipt until permanent status is achieved. Members should also indicate their member status on the application as active or inactive for the semester.

PERMANENT MEMBERSHIP is open to *first-time, active members* who have completed a <u>minimum</u> of 60 transferable units of college course work with a <u>cumulative</u> GPA of 3.5 or higher. At least half of those units must be completed at SBVC, and only 6 units of credit/no credit course work will be credited. Also, the required 12 hours of community/club service in at least 3different activities must be completed that semester as well as attendance to at least 6 AGS meetings. Permanent membership shall be awarded as well to *continuing active members* who have completed a <u>minimum</u> of 60 transferable units of college course work with at least a 3.25 <u>cumulative</u> GPA for <u>two consecutive semesters</u>.

ACTIVE MEMBERSHIP It is mandatory that ALL active members complete 12 hours of club service in at least 3 different activities and attend 6 meetings.

INACTIVE MEMBERSHIP Inactive membership does not require any club service hours or meeting attendance. However, inactive members are not eligible for permanent membership and a 3.0 minimum GPA is required.
